



AGM Election Draws a Record Crowd

Our 2013 Annual General Meeting on April 16th had a record turnout with over 80 people attending.

Trustees Denis Russell and Marshall Heinekey were each re-elected for three-year terms, while Les Howell was returned to the board after a seven year absence to complete the remaining two years of former trustee Wayne Lee's term. The voting results are as follows:

The lake is clearly marked as private property and is not open for swimming or off-roading. In the past, particularly last summer, we have had significant problems with vandalism. Last year damage to our dam alone cost thousands of dollars to repair – a cost that is shared by you, the ratepayers, when rates are set, as are our enhanced security patrol costs.

Campfires are a particular worry to all of us. A forest fire would be devastating and would destroy the Maxwell watershed for many years to come.

The District appreciates your efforts to help conserve this valuable resource. If you are aware of any incidents of vandalism please report them to the District office.
